



## WEST BEACH PRIMARY SCHOOL OUT OF HOURS SPORT CODE OF CONDUCT

West Beach Primary School is committed to ensuring out of hours sport is safe, inclusive, supportive and enjoyable for all students. The focus of school sport is participation, teamwork, learning new skills and having fun.

### **Coaches and Team Managers**

- Must be approved WBPS volunteers with required clearances (working with children check, police clearance and RRHAN-EC training).
- Encourage participation, teamwork and enjoyment over winning.
- Treat all players fairly and respectfully.
- Respect officials, players, parents and spectators.
- Provide equal opportunities for all students where possible.
- Support injured or unwell players appropriately.
- Ensure student medical and emergency information is available at all trainings and games.
- Model positive behaviour at all times.
- If training is organised, coaches must liaise with school administration to confirm the availability, day, time and location (e.g. oval, indoor court, basketball court or netball court) of training.

### **Parents and Carers**

- Ensure children are supervised at trainings and games unless alternative arrangements are approved (e.g. completion of OSHC leave permission slips).
- Support and encourage all players positively.
- Respect coaches, officials, volunteers and sporting rules.
- Do not criticise, ridicule or abuse players, officials or spectators.
- Ensure uniforms and equipment are cared for appropriately.
- Administer any required medication for their child.
- Promote fairness, inclusion and good sportsmanship.

### **Players/Students**

- Play fairly, follow the rules and respect officials.
- Show respect to teammates, opponents, coaches and spectators.
- Encourage others and celebrate good play from all teams.
- Refrain from any bullying, teasing, sledging or inappropriate behaviour.
- Attend training where possible and communicate absences with coaches.
- Remember sport is about fun, teamwork and improving skills.

### **Breaches of the Code**

Any repeated or serious breaches of this Code of Conduct should be reported to the coach, team manager and Sports Coordinator. School leadership will determine appropriate action, which may include suspension from school sport activities.
